E. RIVER STREET CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

On Monday, March 29, 2010, the contractor, Mr. Excavator, will start the E. River Street construction project between East Broad Street and the south city limits. At the beginning of the project the contractor will start at the southern portion of the project by removing trees from the curb lawn area. Then Ohio Edison will relocate forth-five power poles for the new roadway widening.

This project, 1.15 miles in length, will included widening and resurfacing, new curbs & gutters, new drive aprons, new sidewalks, new traffic signs, new traffic signals with mast arms at the intersection of E. River and 4th Street. Replacement of existing 4130 feet 4" watermain with 8" & 12" watermains with new hydrants and service connections.

All vehicular traffic will be maintained during the project. However, motorists may experience delays during construction hours.

The completion date for this project is November 30, 2010
